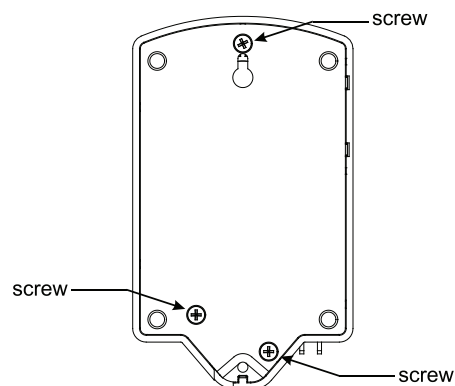
Auxiliary Contacts Specifications

Voltage: 120 VAC

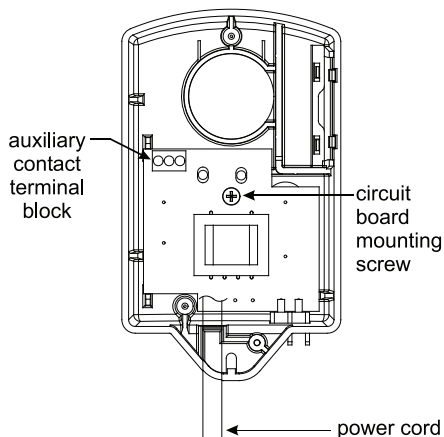
Current: 5 amps max. N/O
3 amps max. N/C

NOTE: This unit includes auxiliary contact option. Due to increased power consumption, if an alarm condition occurs while on battery backup power, this option will reduce the life of the battery.

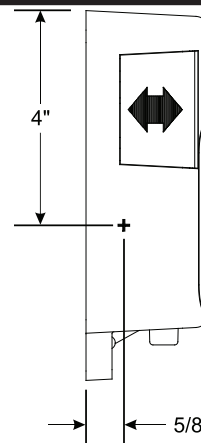
1. Remove enclosure screws and back cover.



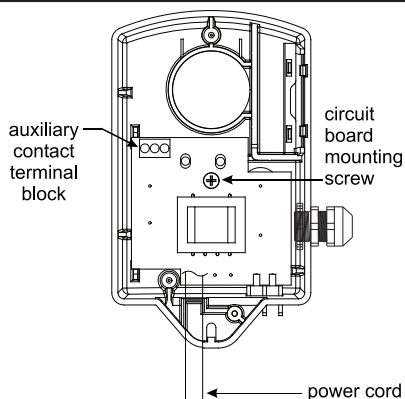
2. Remove screw, circuit board, and power cord.



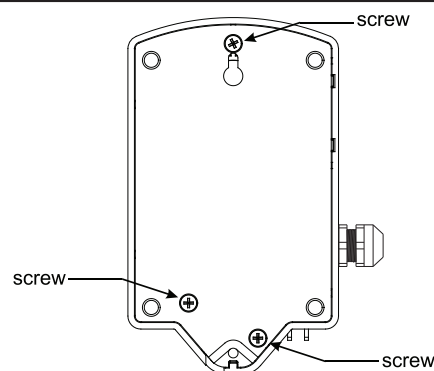
3. Drill hole and install strain relief (not included).



4. Replace circuit board, power cord, and screw. Connect wires to terminal block for auxiliary contacts.



5. Replace back cover and screws.
